### **CURSILLO**

Cursillo literally means "little course" and is an intense three-day spiritual retreat, the purpose of which is a deep personal encounter with Jesus Christ. Those who experience the Cursillo Movement know it is more than just three days of religious instruction. It is an effort to change the spiritual environment, to bring Jesus Christ into the world.

To understand what the Cursillo Movement is all about, a person must first realize that the Cursillo Movement is a method of spirituality. This method for living one's faith has a twofold goal. The first goal is the internal renewal of the person. The second goal is the Christianizing of the person's environment. The first goal is seen as the absolutely necessary step to achieve the second goal. But the Cursillo Movement philosophy is that the first goal is meaningless unless there is also a sincere commitment to the second.
