Friday, November 2nd, 9:00 a.m.

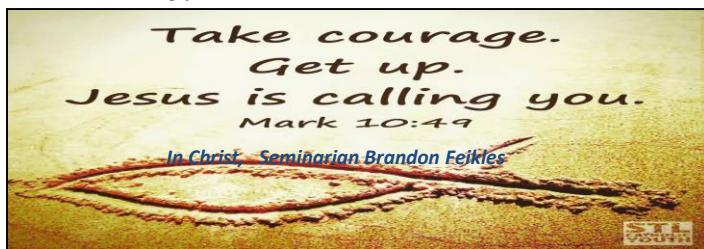
Friday, November 2nd, 7:00 p.m. This mass includes special attention to those who died this past year and their families.

CHOOSE CHRIST

God's plan for us is always to return back to His Fatherly Heart, no matter what kind of terrible or shameful situations we find ourselves in. And upon return, we are told we will *shout for joy* just like those Israelites did in exile, and this is because what we long for the most will be given back to us... God! God NEVER stops laboring for us. And just as it was a journey for the Israelites to get right with God again, so it is with us. They were given signs that the time is coming, so we too are given signs that God is working in our lives to rescue us.

Jeremiah's prophecy is that God will gather the *blind and the lame* when it is time for return, and this prophecy from antiquity took on flesh in the 1st century when the Jews realized that Jesus, being recognized as God's promised Messiah to come (Son of David), has gathered this blind man, which pointed to something greater. But this home isn't a "land" like it was before; no... it is a state of being. Jesus healed this man, but underneath that, He freed this man from slavery of the heart. He does so for us too.

Our journey back into God's Heart takes time and patience as we examine the signs He works in our midst. He does that not to make us miserable, but to make sure that every pocket of our hearts that needs loved, receives love. Are you noticing God's saving actions in your life? Are you noticing where He wants to heal you? If not, pray for the grace to see! Tell Him what you want! Hear Him ask you the questions for the Gospel today, and respond from your heart to Him. For surely He is asking you: *what do you want Me to do for you*, and do not be afraid... for *Jesus is calling you*.
